




The W600/W900 Virtual Sensor Input


Virtual Input combines 2 actual inputs in to one calculated input. Inputs can be any sensor input, analog input, flowmeter rate, the other virtual input, pulse relay % or analog output %.


Virtual Inputs can be found in the Inputs menu, at the end of the list.

1. From the Main Menu, press INPUTS
2. Scroll down until you see V1 and V2



3. Enter the menu and change it from *Not Used* to *Calculation*





...and then press the Configure key.

Select which calculation mode for your Virtual Sensor:

-Ratio (Input / Input 2)

For example, Cycles of Concentration;

Makeup conductivity must be Input 2 and both sensor must be in the same units of measure

-Total (Input + Input 2)


For example, total flow rate

-Difference (Input – Input 2)

For example, differential pressure

-% Difference [(Input - Input 2) / Input]

For example, % Rejection in Reverse Osmosis



**Select the 2 inputs for your Virtual Input.**

Inputs can be any sensor input, analog input, flowmeter rate, the other virtual input, pulse relay % or analog output %.

In the example below, it shows 2 flowmeters being selected as Input and Input2, and the Calculation that is being applied is Ratio.
